Enabling health research collaborations across the TAAHC network

The TAAHC Community of Interest webinar series aims to create connections between clinician scientists (of all disciplines), academic health researchers, and clinicians who are interested in research (but not sure where to start). Each session will be shaped for relevance across the whole of TAAHC and for people with a variety of research experience.

There are four overarching research themes that guide TAAHC activities (<u>TAAHC Research Themes</u>). By focusing on the TAAHC research themes and priorities areas, participants will be able to form working groups or research collaborations to apply for research funding, including <u>TAAHC Research Funding</u>.
