### About the Opportunity

As Maternal and Child Health Midwife/Nurse, you will work closely with Maternal Child Health Workers to provide direct and comprehensive child health and midwifery services to the communities of Cape York. You will deliver a culturally sensitive clinical service across the Maternal and Child Health continuum, within a multidisciplinary team.

This is a FIFO position from Cairns. A typical week involves flying out from Cairns on Monday morning and returning to Cairns on Thursday evening. Administration and reporting is completed on Friday in the Cairns office. You will be provided with accommodation and a travel allowance of up to \$113 per day as a FIFO employee.

- Tertiary qualification in Nursing and Midwifery and current registration with the Australian Health Practice Registration Authority (APHRA) as a Registered Nurse and Midwife
- Demonstrated competence in clinical and problem solving skills with the ability to plan, coordinate and evaluation increasingly complex client care across the maternal and child health continuum
- Knowledge of current Queensland Child Protection Legislation, policies and procedures and the demonstrated ability to apply these principals within the context of a maternal and child health program
- Understanding of the historical and contemporary issues that impact on Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and their communities, particularly in Cape York
- Ability to communicate sensitively and effectively with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in accordance with community protocols and customs
