CPR training

For nurses and non-clinical staff working within general practice

Registrations are now open for nurses and nonclinical staff working within general practice to access free CPR training in Townsville.

Background

The Australian General Practice Accreditation Limited (AGPAL) Standards 5th Edition: Compliance Data identified that *Standard 8 Criterion C8.1 Education and training of non-clinical staff* was not being met in general practice. It is also noted that general practices are required to have completed basic life support training to maintain their accreditation. As a result, NQPHN have invested in the provision of CPR training across the NQ catchment to support general practice in maintaining their high standard of care.

The CPR training sessions will describe the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines. This unit applies to all persons who may be required to provide CPR in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.
