Town

Ingham Family Medical Practice is an RACGP and ACRRM accredited teaching practice, located in the town of Ingham, North Queensland (RRMA5 classification, RA3). Ingham is a rural centre towards the southern end of the Wet Tropics World Heritage area. Locals and visitors enjoy a diverse array of natural attractions and community activities.

Camping, bushwalking, bird watching and fishing are all popular past-times, with several national parks of worldwide acclaim nearby – Hinchinbrook Island (Australia's biggest island National Park), the Great Barrier Reef (a World Heritage site), Wallaman Falls (Australia's highest waterfall) and Tyto Wetlands are just a few of the many locations of interest.

A 'sugar town' on the Bruce Highway, 115 kilometres north of Townsville, our population is approximately 10,900. We are home to the longest jetty (5.75 kilometres) in the southern hemisphere and Queensland's largest sugar mill. Ingham holds an annual Italian Festival and Maraka Festival, a rodeo and also has many sporting and community groups. The town has two supermarkets, a number of specialty stores, two high schools (one private, one public), several primary schools (including one private), a library and a cinema

Practice Details – Ingham Family Medical Practice

Ingham Family Medical Practice is on the highway at the northern end of town. It is a purpose-built building and has been operating for 30 years. Formerly known as Ingham Medical Centre, it is now operating as Ingham Family Medical Practice and has been since 2005. Currently, there are three (3) full time Doctors, and we are looking to recruit a further doctors.

The practice principal is a college examiner for ACCRM and RACGP, a trainer for John Flynn and James Cook University and supervisor to Interns who rotate every 10 weeks from The Townsville Hospital. Dr Brett Scott holds Diplomas in Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Ophthalmology and has much Paediatric and Emergency medicine experience.

Our practice offers audiometry, spirometry, skin checks and ECGs. We do a variety of health checks and medicals. Sullivan and Nicolaides Pathology are on site, as well as Rural Medical Imaging who provide CT, USS and X-ray. We have visiting allied health services such as a podiatrist, an audiologist, a dental prosthetist, a diabetes educator and visiting Orthopaedic Surgeon. Registered and enrolled nurses provide continuous medical officer support, as well as performing pap smears, asthma and diabetes education.

We are a registered Q-fever and yellow fever vaccination centre, as well as providing the usual private and NHS vaccinations.

Visits to our patients at nursing homes are undertaken, and a good relationship exists with all three facilities in our area.

As a practice, we have regular social evenings and family outings. Beachfront accommodation for the suitable applicant is available.
