- **USB peripherals:** For vital readings and patient monitoring.
- **Remote consultation capability:** Connect with general practitioners and specialists from the comfort of the RACH.

- using various USB devices such as ECG, digital stethoscope, and otoscope with telehealth
- telehealth tips and tricks.
