


### My Health App



My health app, available for mobile and tablet, lets you view key health information which have been uploaded to My Health Record. You will need a myGov account linked to My Health Record and to have accessed your My Health Record at least once through a web browser.

# Through this app, one can access their key health information that have been uploaded to My Health record such as

- Shared health summaries
- Discharge summaries
- Event summaries
- Prescription and dispense records
- Goals of care
- Specialist letters
- eReferrals
- Pharmacist Shared Medicines List
- Diagnostic imaging report







- Pathology reports Personally entered information
- Personal health summary
- Personal health notes
- Advance care planning documents other information

#### Other information

- Medicare Benefits Schedule (MBS), Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA), Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS) and Repatriation Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (RPBS) claims
- Australian Organ Donor Register decisions
- Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) records

#### New functionality has been introduced that allows consumers to

- Store electronic prescriptions
- View and manage your Active Script List
- · Add emergency contacts
- Add, edit or remove Allergies and Medicines information in your My Health Record.

Please note: An 'Active Script Activation Code' needs to be sent to you by the Pharmacy to link your Active Script List to my health app, allowing you to view and manage your Active Script List.

The app also lets you share documents that contain your health information with other people or organisation.

The app can be downloaded from App Store or Google Play.


Access electronic prescriptions and check Active Script List

### **Medicines & electronic prescriptions**

View and manage electronic prescriptions and medicines lists

#### Features:

- · Add, share or delete electronic prescriptions
- · Manage Active Script List/s and who can access them
- · Add, edit or delete medications taken
- View medicines history displaying from a range of medicines information sources like prescribed and/or dispensed data.




## **Active Script List (ASL)**

### View and manage ASL

#### Features:

- Link ASL to my health app by using an activation code provided by pharmacies and some GP's
- Un-link ASL when needed
- Manage which healthcare providers can access your ASI

Remember, ASL registration is still done at a pharmacy. Once registered, linking this service will be possible in the app.
