Course overview

This course allows practice staff to take the next step in their medical career and assist in a range of front and backend medical and administrative tasks to support a team of medical practitioners.

- attending or viewing webinars
- five days of workshops over the two-year study period
- support of workplace supervisors to observe demonstration of tasks (GP or RN for clinical tasks, and administration supervisor for administration tasks).

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for the Higher-Level Skills funding, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Queensland resident.
- Be aged 15 years or over, and no longer at school.
- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants) or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency.
- Not hold, or be enrolled in, a
 Certificate IV level or higher
 qualification (not including
 qualifications completed at school and
 foundation skills training).

Applicants must also be working in a private general practice or AMS, located in the northern Queensland region.
