

The Nurse Re-entry Program supports general practices to build their capability by hosting nurses in supervised placements. Strengthen your team by hosting a returning nurse and supporting their journey to regain full registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA). Eligible practices may receive a \$2,000 grant to support the placement.

Which practices can apply?

Practices must be accredited and have an existing registered nurse (minimum 12 months experience in general practice) who can supervise the re-entry nurse for the level and duration required by the NMBA.

How it works

- 1. Complete an expression of interest form.
- **2.** We confirm eligibility and match your practice with a nurse.
- **3.** Eligible practices receive a \$2,000 grant to support the placement.
- **4.** On completion, your practice will have a fully registered nurse, ready to join your team.
