- > Clinical Audit Queries: Fast, simplified queries for patient recalls and operational tasks.

	Reports	Clinical Audit Queries
Purpose	Strategic planning, quality improvement, accreditation.	Patient recall, project enrolment.
Complexity	High detailed logic and processing.	Low, simplified logic.
Types	Summary and patient list reports.	Audit specific patient lists.
Data depth	Rich insights, graphs, filters, patient level data.	Basic patient lists with minimal processing.
Access point	Reports tab.	Reports tab \longrightarrow Clinical audit queries button.
Export options	Excel, CSV, SMS formats.	Excel, CSV, SMS formats.
Use cases	Chronic disease, screening, accreditation, MyMedicare.	eGFR , 60, hep C, ADHD, osteoporosis, etc.
Patient removal option	Yes. 12-month exclusion per reports.	Yes. 12-month exclusion per audit.
Integration	SMS recall, desktop filtering, GP specific lists.	SMS recall, hover over tooltips.
