

CPR training

For Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations (ACCHOs), Aboriginal Medical Services (AMSs), general practices and pharmacies.

Northern Queensland Primary Health Network invites EOIs from clinical and non-clinical staff working in ACCHOs, AMSs, general practices and pharmacies in the northern Queensland region to access funded CPR training.

This course is delivered in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines.

Course delivery and requirements:

- Online learning component of approximately 40 minutes.
- Face-to-face practical session of 1 hour.
- Participants must have the physical capacity to perform the practical demonstrations, such as two-minutes of uninterrupted CPR on the floor.
