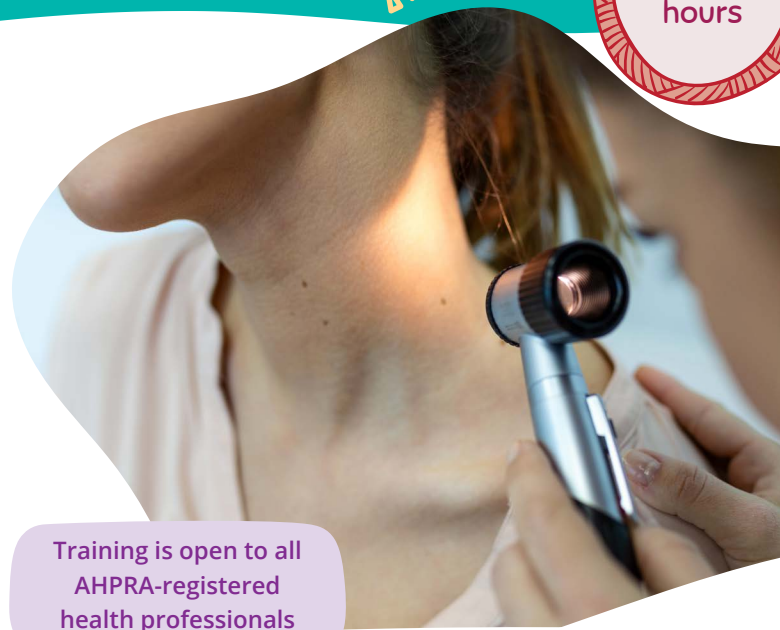
## About the DermEX Dermoscopy Webinar Series

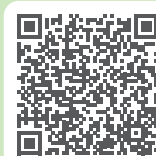

- > high-yield dermoscopic clues for Basal Cell Carcinoma (BCC), Squamous Cell Carcinoma (SCC), and melanoma, with practical triage guidance.
