Northern Queensland Primary Health Network (NQPHN) invites expressions of interest from GPs working in Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations (ACCHOs), Aboriginal Medical Services (AMS) or general practices across northern Queensland to access partially funded ALS training.

Delivered by an Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) accredited course centre, this course is aligned with current ANZCOR guidelines and meets RACGP requirements for ALS and BLS training.

During the course, you will develop the knowledge and skills required to:

- Recognise and manage the deteriorating patient using a structured ABCDE approach.
- Deliver standardised CPR in adults (Basic Life Support (BLS)).
- Manage cardiac arrest by working with a multidisciplinary team in an emergency.
- Become an effective and confident team member and leader by utilising non-technical skills.

Course delivery:

- Online theory component delivered via Zoom.
- Weekend practical half-day workshop.
