Northern Queensland Primary Health Network (NQPHN) invites expressions of interest from eligible clinical and non-clinical staff\* working across northern Queensland to access funded CPR training.

This course is delivered in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council guideline.

### Course delivery and requirements

- Online pre-course work of approx. 40 minutes (which must be completed prior to attending the face-to-face session).
- Face-to-face practical session of 1 hour.
- Participants must have the physical capacity to perform the practical demonstrations, such as two-minutes of uninterrupted CPR on the floor.

### Who should apply?\*

Clinical and non-clinical staff working in:

- Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations (ACCHOs) or Aboriginal Medical Services (AMS')
- allied health practices
- general practices
- pharmacies
- residential aged care homes (RACHs).

Sessions have been scheduled in Cairns, Townsville, and Mackay. Additional sessions for rural and remote participants (MMM 4–7) may be scheduled based on demand identified through the EOI process.

Funded places for these courses are limited.
