EOIs are now invited from eligible healthcare professionals working in primary care practices across northern Queensland to undertake the [Cervical Screening for Healthcare Professionals course](#), delivered by [True Relationships and Reproductive Health](#).

The aim of this course is to equip healthcare professionals with the knowledge, skills, and clinical competence required to become cervical screening providers in accordance with the National Cervical Screening Program.

Successful completion of the course enables participants to practice as non-medical cervical screening providers* within their workplace, in accordance with their approved scope of practice and organisational governance requirements.

*As per the National Cervical Screening Program Quality Framework document, 'Non-medical cervical screening providers' is an umbrella term, used to describe all healthcare professionals who are not medical practitioners and who offer a cervical screening service.
